



PUBLIC NOTICE

The President of the Republic of Sierra Leone formally launched **The Sierra Leone Local Content Agency Act (SLLCA)** on the 17th of March 2016. The Local Content Agency Act seeks to strengthen the linkages between foreign companies or enterprises and the local economy as well as requires investors to meet a set of performance targets in their operations regarding skills transfer and improved technology.

The Act establishes the Sierra Leone Local Content Agency to provide for the development of Local Content in a range of sectors of the economy, to promote ownership and control of productive sectors by citizens of Sierra Leone and to provide for other related matters.

In line with the above the Agency wishes to inform the general public that it shall be embarking on a nationwide consultation to engage all relevant stakeholders, as it is only through this means the Agency can guarantee participation and collaboration of key stakeholders as well as generate adequate information to aid the implementation of the Act.

The Consultation exercise would run for a 4 months period starting from **July – October 2016**. A series of workshops per stakeholder group would be held in Freetown being the largest district and Nationwide
